Introduction

- 1. Vs. 6 The subject of why the book was written.
 - A. When a church moves away from the gospel.
 - 1) Believers become weak.
 - 2) Believers become open to heresy.
 - 3) Believers will easily compromise their faith.
 - 4) Believers can easily become acceptable of unbiblical practices.
- 2. Jesus was very clear in his teaching on this matter.

Mark 8:36-37 (NKJV)

³⁶ For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? ³⁷ Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?

Not Paul usual greeting – Vs. 6.

- 1. Paul usually gives praise to the church and the work they are doing.
 - A. Paul jumps right into why he was writing.
 - 1) You have so quickly moved from the truth.
 - 2) You were so easily persuaded.
- 2. "So soon removed" (vs. 6).
 - A. Written in the present tense.
 - 1) In process (happening as he was writing).
 - B. Church established 1st missionary journey (AD 46).
 - 1) Letter written AD 49.
 - C. "Removed" a relocation.
- 3. Jesus gave a clear statement concerning someone who moves away from the gospel.

Luke 9:62 (NKJV)

⁶² But Jesus said to him, "No one, having put his hand to the plow, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God."

- 1. 1990 86% of Americans called themselves Christians.
 - A. Today 62% (2024).
 - B. One interesting trend is with this static.
 - 1) 2019-2024 the percentages stabilized.
 - a. This was the Covid era.
 - C. Out of these 62% only 33% attend services regularly.
- 2. Three most dreaded words "Thou Shalt Not".
 - A. People don't want to be told what to do.
- 3. 1 in 5 Americans say they have no religious identity.
 - A. 1 in 4 Americans say they will not have a religious funeral.
- 4. 2007-2-24
 - A. Americans identifying with a religion other than Christianity has increased.
- 5. Majority of Americans have a spiritual belief.
 - A. 86% say the body is spirit and soul.
 - B. 83% believe in God or a universal spirit.
 - C. 79% say there is something beyond our natural world.
 - D. 70% believe in an afterlife (heaven, hell, or both).

- 6. Trends of younger adults.
 - A. 46% identify as Christian.
 - B. 27% pray daily.
 - C. 25% attend a service monthly.
 - D. 43% are religiously unaffiliated.
