

*A Faithful Learner*  
*Galatians 6:6-10*

- ***Foundational Life Principle – Teachers & Student***

1. We are all learning by those who have gone before us.
2. Body of Christ – students are responsibilities to the teacher.
3. Reminder – That doesn't make the teacher/preacher any better than the student (reference Vs. 3).

*Vs. 6 raises a question.*

***How does a student do good to the teacher?***

*Vs. 6 Answers the question.*

***By sharing in the ministry.***

- ***Biblical Principle #1 – When God's chosen servant faithfully teaches the Word, we are called to both support and engage actively in the ministry.***

- ***Biblical Principle #2 – Being actively involved in the ministry helps us avoid falling into deception.***  
*Vs. 7*

***God's Word is not for interpretation it is for application.***

- ***Biblical Principle #3 – When God's messenger faithfully proclaims God's truth, it is our responsibility to support God's work by putting these teachings into practice in our own lives.***

- ***Biblical Principle #4 – When we disregard God's Word and the messenger He sends, we are, in effect, showing disrespect or rejection toward God Himself.*** Vs. 7

- ***Biblical Principle #5 – Sowing and reaping.*** Vs. 7

- ***Sowing to the flesh reaps fleshly results.*** Vs. 8

*Hebrews 11:24–25*

*24 By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter; 25 Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;*

- ***Sowing to the Spirit reaps life.*** Vs. 8

*"Sow for yourselves righteousness; Reap in mercy; Break up your fallow ground, For it is time to seek the LORD, Till He comes and rains righteousness on you" Hosea 10:12*

- ***Biblical Principle #6 – Those who participate in and uphold the teaching of God's Word are promised a reward.*** Vs. 9

- ***Biblical Principle #7 – Just Do It.*** Vs. 10
