## Faith Check - Part 2 Galatians 2:11-21 Focal Vs. 15-16

#### Introduction

Is there a work man can do, or a law man can keep that will make him perfect? No Galatians foundation is salvation is a gift from God, not of works.

- The major conflict was Gentiles must adopt Jewish customs to be right with God.
- Paul's message is Christ is sufficient.
- Peter's action was contrary to Paul's message.

## Comparison of Jews & Gentiles – Vs. 15.

- 1. Peter's actions only supported the Judaizers' argument.
  - A. Argument Jews are more entitled than the Gentiles.
- 2. We who are Jews by nature we are entitled to God's favor.
  - A. Gentiles must do more to gain the favor of God.
- 3. Note the wording of vs.  $15 \frac{\text{"Sinners of the Gentiles"}}{\text{.}}$ 
  - A. This term represents the Judaizers' thinking.
    - 1) It means ranked sinners.

Faith Check – We must be careful we can take on the same mindset.

- 1. Subconsciously we can look around and think I'm better than that person.
  - A. We tend to classify people.
- 2. Jews somehow took on the thinking they were entitled to God because they were Jews by birth.

Christianity has never been a position of privilege and entitlement.

Christianity is a position of responsible to represent Christ.

Law and works will never justify us to God – Vs. 16.

Truth about man.

- 1. We are short of God's glory (Rom. 3:23).
- 2. We are imperfect beings (Ecc. 7:20).
- 3. We are incomplete (Col. 2:9-10).

#### Isaiah 64:6 (KJV)

<sup>6</sup> But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

#### Faith in Jesus Christ justifies man to God – Vs. 16.

Justification – Diakioun

- 1. Greek verbs ending in "oun" means to count to someone's credit.
  - A. Apply to your account.
- 2. Justify is a legal term taken from the court.
  - A. Man is standing on trial before God.
- 3. Jesus takes on man's condemnation when he went to the cross.
- 4. When we accept God by faith we are justified with God.

## Grasp this and it will help your faith.

- 1. You are still guilty
- 2. You are not innocent.
- 3. Christ righteousness has been applied to your account.

#### Application

- 1. We must learn to begin each day dying to self.
- 2. Dying to self means we put off and put on.

# Colossians 3:9-10 (KJV)

<sup>9</sup> Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds; <sup>10</sup> And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:
