Legalism – is a system in which a person seeks to gain God's acceptance by what they do.

## Biblical Truth #3 - God's Covenant & Promise - Vs. 15-18

Justification comes by God's Eternal Promise (Covenant).

- 1. What is a covenant?
  - A. An agreement between two parties.
- God's eternal covenant Vs. 15
- God's covenant was made with Abraham's seed Vs. 16.
- God gave His covenant of faith before He gave the law Vs. 17.
- Our eternal promise inheritance was by promise, not by law Vs. 18.

Biblical Truth #4 - The Law Has No Power - Vs. 19-22.

The purpose of the law – Vs. 19.

1. To reveal sin!

Principle – Awareness of sin can awaken its power, but knowledge alone will never bring victor over it.

A focus on rules will never lead to obedience, it will stimulate disobedience.

Paul raises a question and then gives the answer

Is the Law Bad? - Vs. 21

1. God forbid.

Primary purpose of the law

Three categories

- 1. Ceremonial laws
- 2. Civil laws.
- 3. Moral laws

These are not path to salvation, but guidance for living in a way that honors God.

Set Free from the Law. – Vs. 22
