The purpose of the law – Vs. 19.

1. To reveal sin!

Principle – Awareness of sin can awaken its power, but knowledge alone will never bring victory over it.

A focus on rules will never lead to obedience, it will stimulate disobedience.

Set Free from the Law. - Vs. 22

Principle - Grace triumphs over sin, through faith in Jesus, victory is won.

Biblical Truth #5 – Faith in Christ: Our Source of Transformation.

Faith in Christ frees us from the supervision of the law. Vs. 23-25

#### Three illustrations

- 1. The law was a prison for man. (Vs. 23)
- 2. The law was a schoolmaster (guardian). (Vs.24)
- 3. We are set free from the bond of the law. (Vs. 25)

# Faith brings us into God's family. – Vs. 26-27

Question – How do we know we are justified by faith and not by the law?

- 1. Law is always a focus on effort.
- 2. Paul says, "faith makes us children of God". (Vs. 26)

Faith in Christ makes us one. – Vs. 28

Faith in Christ makes us heirs of the promise. – Vs. 29

- 1. Faith moves us from self-reliance to Christ-reliance.
- 2. Faith produces inner renewal.
- 3. Faith fuels obedience.
- 4. Faith keeps us future focused.
