God called Paul to Jerusalem - Vs. 2.

- 1. Here is what's happening.
 - A. Paul preaching 11 years.
 - B. God was changing people (especially Gentiles).
- 2. They were confusing people.
 - A. They were telling those who believed they couldn't be saved until they converted to Judaism.

Paul meet with other church leaders – Vs. 2.

Barnabas and Titus proved these Judaizers wrong – Vs. 3-5.

We can't impress God by our degrees – Vs. 6.

- 1. Paul didn't hold back words here.
 - A. Paul said, "God accepteth no man's person".
 - 1) God show no partiality.
- 2. Salvation is only by the gospel.

Paul was preaching the same Jesus Peter was preaching – Vs. 7-10.
