Introduction

1. Our current world we are seeing a great falling away from God (2 Thess. 2:3, 2 Tim. 3:1-5).
 - A. In the evangelical realm you may have heard them speak of a great revival.
 - B. Can there be a 4th great awakening in America?
 - 1) Yes
2. We know scripture teaches in the end
 - A. Men will be lovers of themselves.
 - B. Lovers of pleasure
 - C. Lovers of money
 - D. Etc.
3. We clearly know morality will be at an all-time low when the end comes.
 - A. Evil will be at an all-time high.
 - B. Decency will be a thing of the past.

There is always this reoccurring question about the Tribulation.

We people be saved during the Tribulation?

1. I can give you a clear answer of Yes to this question.
2. Many think salvation will not be possible because the Holy Spirit is no longer present.
 - A. We know today a person is drawn by the power of the H.S. within their spirit to salvation.

John 6:44

44 No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him

3. The real impact of the H.S. removal during the Tribulation.
 - A. Evil will no longer be restrained.

2 Thessalonians 2:6-7

6 And now ye know what withholdeth (restraining) that he might be revealed in his time. 7 For the mystery of iniquity (lawlessness) doth already work: only he who now letteth (restrain) will let, until he be taken out of the way.

- B. Due to the evil that will run ramped during the Tribulation.
- A. People will seek peace and right.
- C. Today we have a famine of hearing the word of God.

Amos 8:11-12

11 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD: 12 And they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east, they shall run to and fro to seek the word of the LORD, and shall not find it.

- A. During these perilous times people will hunger for truth.

How will God's truth be proclaimed during the final years?

God's Messengers - Revelation 7:1-4

1. *There is an angel that has the seal of God (vs. 2).*
2. *Angels mission – Seal these chosen servants of God (vs. 3).*
3. *Those chosen servants protected from the coming judgement God is pouring out on the earth (vs. 3).*

The Mission of the 144,000 – Revelation 14:1-6

1. *One mission – Proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ.*
2. *How long?*
 - A. *The duration of the Tribulation.*

3. *They are protected from the;*
 - A. *Judgement of God*
 - B. *Antichrist*
 - C. *Evil*

Revelation 7:3

3 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads.

Two Witness – Rev. 11:1-6

1. Who are the witness?
 - A. ***Enoch & Elijah***
 - 1) Some say Moses.
 - 2) There is a good argument for that.
 - B. I believe Enoch & Elijah because these 2 men have never experience physical death.
 - 1) It is appointed unto man once to die.
2. ***Where is the location of their ministry?***
 - A. ***Jerusalem***
3. ***How long will their ministry last?***
 - A. ***3 ½ years***
 - B. During the 1st half of the Tribulation
 - C. How do we know that?
