# By Faith We Are Justified! Part 1 Galatians 3:1-5

#### Introduction

- 1. Two questions
  - A. How do we know God will justify us?
  - B. How do we know God will accept us and give us eternal life?
- Every person wrestles with these questions.
- They're not just theological, they're personal, eternal, and urgent.

### The Heart of Galatians (Gal. 3:1-4:7).

1. Paul lays out a foundational truth that echoes through all of Scripture.

#### We are justified by faith not by works.

- 2. These truths answer the deepest questions.
  - A. Faith gives acceptance, belonging, eternal hope.

## God's Holiness vs. Man's Efforts

Jesus: The Bridge Between God & Man.

- 1. Jesus fully God & fully man.
- 2. This is not just theology it's man's rescue.

### To the Skeptic and the Seeker.

1. How do we prove this to the critical thinker, the skeptic, the one who defies God?

### Biblical Truth #1 – Personal Experience.

Salvation is not achieved by human effort but received by trusting in the Spirit's work. (Vs. 1-2) Threefold work of the Holy Spirit (John 16-7-11)

- 1. To convict the world of
  - A. Sin
  - B. God's righteousness
  - C. Show the coming judgement of God.

Principle: Always examine Scripture for yourself to confirm that what's being taught aligns with God's Word.

Spiritual complacency leads us away from God's truth.

Spiritual growth comes by faith (Vs. 3).

- 1. Nowhere in the Word of God does it teach us works develops spiritual growth.
  - A. Three scriptural examples
    - 1) Romans 11:6 if it works then grace is of no effect.
    - 2) Ephesians 2:8-9 salvation is by faith, works will never accomplish salvation.
    - 3) Hebrews 11:6 without faith we will never please God.

#### Three steps to spiritual growth.

- 1. Growth begins by hearing & obeying God's Word.
- 2. Practicing daily discipline in His Word and ways.
- 3. We develop maturity through daily self-denial & surrender.

# Results of Spiritual growth.

- 1. We learn stand firm against the enemy's schemes (2 Cor. 10:5).
- 2. Our life begins to reflect the image and character of Christ (Col. 3:10, Rom. 8:29).
- 3. Our eyes stay fixed on heaven, where our true citizenship lies. (Phil. 3:20-21).
